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Beginning students study language that can be used in everyday conversation. Listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills in Spanish are emphasized.

*The 7 C's in our class are: Communication, Culture, Connections, Comparisons, Communities*

**Recommended Materials**

1. Folder, notebook
  2. **Grade Distribution**
  3. Grades are based upon an accumulation of points. Points are acquired with homework assignments, group and/or individual projects, etc.
  4. **NOTA:** attending class, participating in class, listening in class, and staying on class is important to your grade. You will have no problems taking any
1. **Daily In-Class work and Participation**
5. This portion of the grade is based upon daily warm-ups, participation in class, and daily in-class work. Cooperation with group members, and participation in class is essential.
1. **Practice, In-class, and projects**
  2. Much of our daily practice (a.k.a. homework/ la tarea) is done in class. Any tarea assigned to be done out of class time is due at the beginning of the next class.
6. **In case of absence:**
  7. **IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to find out what you missed if you were absent.**
  8. Check with Mr. Gaspar's website
  9. ASK Mr. Gaspar!
10. Current grades will be posted on the parent / student grade portal and accessible by students and parents.
11. **Need Help?**
  12. Schedule a time to meet with me and get help / ask questions.

**Responsibilities and Expectations**

13. **Respect:**
  14. If I can stress any WC value in our Spanish class, it is **RESPECT**. Having respect for your teacher, your classmates, and yourself is KEY
  15. "Disrespect including interruptions, talking over others, insulting others, and off-task behavior will be addressed with the appropriate leniency."
  16. **Absenteeism:** Attendance is extremely important to your success in this class as active, in-class participation is crucial to be able to use the language.
  17. **Quality Work:** I expect to receive quality work in quality form. This means:
  18. **I ACCEPT ONLY QUALITY WORK.** Poor quality work, even though it is "done on time" will be a re-do. If it is not done correctly and well.
  19. **Cheating:** Cheating is against school rules and I have a zero tolerance policy. If a student is caught cheating, then their grade on the test will be lowered.
  20. **Online Translators:** I am strongly against the use of online translators for work in this class. Online translators cannot learn for you and will not help you learn.
  21. **Behavior:**
  22. Students will adhere to regulations and consequences for unacceptable behavior as outline in the West Central student handbook. A go home card will be issued.
  23. **Preparations:**
  24. You are expected to arrive to class with all necessary materials, which include: notebook paper, folder/paperwork, iPad, and writing instruments.
- 25. TIPS TO SUCCEED IN CLASS:**
26. **DO NOT SPEAK ENGLISH** in class.
  27. Take the class seriously – have fun! but understand your goals and expectations!
  28. **TAKE NOTES** in class
  29. Do your **HOMEWORK** daily – work hard, work to your potential and abilities in class
  30. **Ask questions** and participate positively in class
  31. If you miss something, make it up ASAP!
  32. *If you feel yourself struggling, if you see you aren't performing to the level of other students, I would be happy to help you extra!*
  33. Use the language with friends outside of class
  34. Don't "frighten" the language – Don't hate on Spanish! Give it a chance and learn something new!
  35. Study daily
